

How to Connect to the KWoodStudents Wireless Network

Directions for Windows 7 or Vista

- 1) In the area of your taskbar known as the “**Notification Area**” click on the little wireless Icon and then click on “**Open Network and Sharing Center**”



- 2) Once that window opens you will see on the left hand side an option to “**Manage Wireless Networks**”. Click that link
- 3) On the next window you will need to choose the option “**Add**” and then you will want to choose to “**Manually create a network profile**”
- 4) You will have to type in the correct network information; any typos will result in you not being able to connect. Here is the information;
 - a. Network Name: KWoodStudents
 - b. Security Type: 802.1X
 - c. Encryption Type: WEP
 - d. Security Key Blank
 - e. Leave “Start this connection automatically” checked
 - f. Click Next



- 5) You will want to click on “**Change the Connection Settings**”.
- 6) Everything on the “**Connection**” tab will stay as default, click on the “**Security**” tab.
- 7) In the middle of the window under “**Choose a network authentication method:**” click settings.
 - a. Uncheck “**Validate server Certificate**”
 - b. Under “**Select Authentication Method:**” click “**Configure**”
 - c. Uncheck the box “**Automatically use my Windows log.....**” then click OK twice.
 - d. Back to the “**Security Tab**” screen, choose advanced settings
 - e. Check the box next to “**Specify authentication mode**” and choose from the drop down “**User Authentication**”
 - f. If you would like you could click on the button for “**Save Credentials**” and enter in your Kwoods username/password in the following format.
 - i. **Kwoods\Username** then your password
