RETURN TO SCHOOL PLAN Learning Environment Options

OPTION #1 - IN-PERSON LEARNING ENVIRONMENT

Students will attend school in-person four days a week (Monday-Thursday, 8am-3pm), with Friday being a remote learning day

Monday-Thursday: Morning: Block schedule of 3 classes Afternoon: Learning Lab

Friday: Remote work day

Families will be able to opt out of in-person afternoon Learning Lab and attend remotely from home, leaving the building prior to the start of lunch.

WHAT IS LEARNING LAB?

Afternoon Learning Labs will offer flexible, supervised, scheduled offerings. The schedule will vary by day and will offer multiple options, including:

- Supervised work time with teachers
- Teacher Office Hours for additional support
- · Small Group work times
- Support Lab (students, especially Middle School students, will be able to get support in study skills and time management)
- · Scheduled Enrichment Activities

OPTION #2 - REMOTE LEARNING ENVIRONMENT

Students will work and attend classes remotely Monday-Thursday and will have small group meetings with teachers on Fridays.

Monday-Thursday:

Morning: Block schedule of 3 classes, log in to live classes via Google Meet or Zoom. Afternoon: Learning Lab/Remote work time

Students will be expected to attend every class session; attendance will be taken.

Friday:

Students will have mandatory small group remote meetings from 8am-12:05pm with all of their teachers, to check-in and have any questions answered.

FOR ALL STUDENTS

- Regardless of Learning Environment chosen, all students enrolled in a class will all take the same class, with the same teacher and the same learning outcomes.
- · All students will follow the same bell schedule.
- If the building is closed to in-person learning, all students will transition to remote learning, following the same bell schedule.
- · Google Classroom will be the home base for all courses. Grades will remain being recorded in MiStar.
- $\cdot\;$ All students and parents will receive technology orientations.
- · All students will be loaned technology for daily use if needed.
- · Attendance will be taken in each class each day.
- · Students IEPs and 504s will continue to be supported fully.
- · After school support and extracurriculars still available for all.
